The History of the Air Transport Auxiliary

Often described as the "Female Few" this talk explores the role of female ATA pilots. The ATA recruited pilots who were unsuitable for the RAF by reason of age, fitness or sex. A quarter of ATA pilots were women. Once female ATA pilots became common knowledge there was public outcry. However, without them, WW2 may have had a different outcome.

The History of the Quick Reaction Alert

Since the early 1960's the RAF has operated a QRA capability. Discover how this evolved from V-bomber aircrews waiting to launch a nuclear retaliatory strike from their dispersal pans across the country, to the powerful **Eurofighter Typhoon used** today to intercept incursions into UK airspace from RAF bases at Lossiemouth, in Moray and Conningsby in Lincolnshire.

British Women in Aviation - The Pioneers

This talk explores the contribution of British women in the world of aviation. It explores the lives and stories of some aviation pioneers, women such as the first fast-jet pilot in the RAF, the only female captain of Concorde and more...

An inspirational talk, highlighting the bravery and skill of British women through the years.

They asked for a Death Ray - what they got was more advantageous. The story of how two unlikely men, and a mathematical formula, changed the tide of the war. They say truth is stranger than fiction. Indeed, it was here.

4 Minute Warning - What would've happened?

We are all aware of the 4 minute warning, the alert that would have been given if a Russian nuclear attack was detected. But what would really have happened? Would we have survived? Would we have wanted to? Please note this talk is **not suitable** for all due to the graphic nature of the content. Please liaise with me if you are considering this presentation for your members.

Flying Past Aviation in Kent
